Opening Comments

Mechanical warewashing machine was not in operation and not assessed as part of this inspection.

8. Times as a public health control; procedures and records

When time only, rather than time and temperature is used as a public health control, records and documentation must be maintained. (114000)

Inspector Comments: Written logs were not being maintained for condiment bar dairy products held outside of temperature control. Ensure written logs are maintained documenting how long foods have been held outside of temperature control.

25. Personal cleanliness and hair restraints

All employees preparing, serving, or handling food or utensils shall wear clean, washable outer garments or uniforms and shall confine hair. (113969, 113971)

Inspector Comments: Employee observed with unrestrained hair; employee restrained hair during inspection. Ensure employees preparing, serving, or handling food or utensils wear hair restraints.

30. Food storage, food storage containers identified

Food shall be stored in an approved manner. (114047, 114049, 114051, 114053, 114055, 114067(h), 114069(b))

Inspector Comments: Unlabeled contain of sugar observed; container was labeled during inspection. Ensure containers are labeled.

45. Floor, walls, and ceilings: built, maintained, and cleaned

Food facility shall be fully enclosed. Walls, floors, and ceilings shall be approved and in good repair. (114143(d), 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272)

Inspector Comments: Escutcheon at drain pipe at mop sink observed bent and detached from the wall. Repair or replace so that no gap around drain pipe remains.
