Opening Comments

A routine inspection was conducted this date for Fresh Kitchen in the Titan Student Union.

The facility re-opened this fall as a new food concept.

The menu for this facility includes:

- Prepackaged meals (salad bowls, snack boxes, chia pudding, etc.)
- Fries
- Grilled cheese sandwiches
- Pre-made soups
- Mac and cheese

NOTE: The facility replaced existing cooking equipment under the mechanical exhaust hood with other cooking equipment from another facility within the Titan Student Union. Before any changes can be done within the food facility, the facility shall contact CSUF EHS and other pertaining agencies for approval prior to any changes.

30. Food storage, food storage containers identified

Food shall be stored in an approved manner. (114047, 114049, 114051, 114053, 114055, 114067(h), 114069(b))

Inspector Comments: Observed open paper bags of fries wrapped with plastic wrap inside the undercounter refrigerator near the cookline.

Once a package is opened, the facility shall transfer the contents to a container that is food grade and washable.

Inspector Comments: 1. Observed dust, debris, and white substances on the gasket and hinges of the undercounter reach in refrigerator.

Clean and maintain the equipment in clean and in good condition at all times.

- 2. Observed missing front panel on the fryer. Replace missing front panel on the fryer.
- 3. Observed a leak inside the double door True refrigerator in the back kitchen. The facility shall make the necessary repairs for the leak.
- 4. Observed ice build up along the door of the walk-in freezer. Determine the cause of the ice build up and make the necessary repairs to prevent ice build up.
