### **Opening Comments**

A routine inspection was conducted at Panda Express inside the Titan Student Union.

From the previous routine inspection, Panda Express uses a soak solution to clean the filters at the mechanical exhaust hood. After the previous meeting with the third party vendor that provides the soak solution, it was agreed that the vendor shall provide a record logging the pH of the solution prior to disposing the solution down the janitorial sink.

During the routine inspection this date, Panda Express was not able to provide the record log of the pH for the soak solution prior to disposal. Ensure to send the records to CSUF EHS within 7 days. The facility shall keep a copy of the record on site and make it available for review during routine inspections.

The janitorial sink is currently out of service. The facility is using another janitorial sink in the interim at another location within the building.

# 35. Equipment/utensils approved, installed, clean, good repair, capacity

All utensils and equipment shall be approved, fully operative, and in good repair. (114130, 114130.1, 114130.2, 114130.3, 114130.5, 114130.6, 114132, 114133, 114137, 114139, 114153, 114155, 114165, 114165, 114167, 114169, 114175, 114177, 114180, 114182)

Inspector Comments: Observed damage stainless steel on the door of the walk-in refrigerator. Repair damaged door.

#### 41. Plumbing: proper backflow devices

All plumbing, plumbing fixtures and grease interceptors shall be installed in compliance with local plumbing ordinances. (114171, 114183.1, 114190, 114192, 114193, 114193, 114199, 114201, 114269)

Inspector Comments: Observed a leak at the faucet of the 3-compartment sink. Repair the sink as needed.

Corrected on site.

### 45. Floor, walls, and ceilings: built, maintained, and cleaned

Food facility shall be fully enclosed. Walls, floors, and ceilings shall be approved and in good repair. (114143(d), 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272)

Inspector Comments: Observed broken floor tiles in the walk way in front of the walk-in refrigerator. Replace broken floor tiles.
